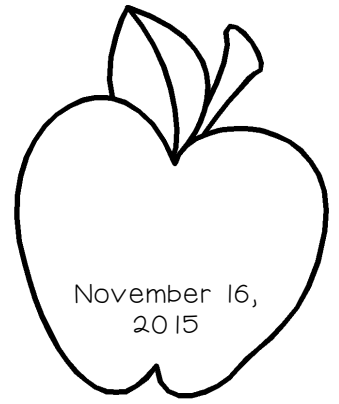

This week we are wrapping up the Read Alouds and learning new vocabulary related to Unit 3: Life Depends on Water. Students will vote for their first Book Club book to read in this unit on Friday.

Students completed QQ 3-1 over liquid measurement last week and their first multiplication Fluency Check since we wrapped up Unit 2 😊 Look for a new Math Newsletter as we start learning about reading the clock and finding elapsed time.

We are learning how to find the distance between two locations on a map. We are also discussing what direction we travel to get from one place to another. Students will enjoy researching a famous location before testing over this chapter 😊
