

When giving a retell of a story, it's important to give a summary of the big ideas, but not re-telling the whole thing. Here is an example of how to stick to the nitty gritty, and leave the extra details out 😊

"The Introduction says, WHEN, WHERE, WHO, WHAT..."

Ex: Miss Ronhovde was very tired, so she made a pot of coffee in the teacher's lounge during morning recess.

"FIRST, NEXT, THEN, and IN THE END..."

- First, she dismissed the students to recess.
- Next, she went to the lounge and measured out the coffee.
- Then, she poured herself a glass when the pot was finished.
- In the End, she headed back to the classroom. (Wrap it up → Miss Ronhovde was so happy to have her morning coffee 😊 She was not tired anymore.)
